10:30 - Childcare provided on the Lutheran Playground (weather permitting)

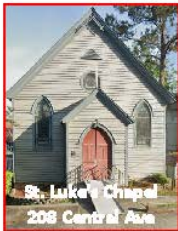
10:30 - Holy Eucharist

The Midweek Eucharist will also be held at St. Luke's this Wednesday, October 9 at 5:15 followed by Bible Study, and choir practice at 6:30.

Please see the map below with suggested parking options. On Sunday mornings, all who are able are encouraged to park in the town garage (enter from Short Central via W. Richardson), and to save the street parking in front of the chapel along Central for those with mobility issues. We additionally have been given permission to park at Epiphany after 10:00. *Good Shepherd members are asked to avoid parking along 2nd South Street between Central & Pine Streets on Sundays, as that is primarily used by members of St. Luke's.

However, please **save any open spaces in front of the chapel along Central Avenue for those with mobility issues.**

For all who are able to walk one block away the **parking garage on Short Central is free and open to the public** (and covered!) Church of the Epiphany has also graciously given us permission to use their parking spaces **after 10AM once their service has let out, at 300 Central Ave.**

Since St. Luke's mid-morning service begins at 11, **please avoid using the parking spaces along W 2nd South Street between Central and Pine Streets.**
